TOXIN	COMMON SOURCES	CAT/DOG
<b>Chocolate</b>	Chocolate desserts and baked goods	Both (most common with dogs)
<b>Alcohol</b>	Drinks at parties and spilled beverages	Both
<b>Onions and garlic</b>	Common in party foods, dips, grilled foods	Both (cats are more sensitive)
<b>Fireworks debris</b>	Spent fireworks and chemical residue in yards	Both
<b>THC / marijuana products</b>	Edibles and cannabis products	Both (most common with dogs)
<b>Xylitol</b>	Ingredient in low-sugar and sugar-free gum, candy, baked goods, and supplements	Dogs



## Nature

TOXIN	COMMON SOURCES	CAT/DOG
<b>Oleander</b>	Flowering landscaping shrubs	Both
<b>Sago palm</b>	Ornamental plant in landscaping and patios	Both (most severe for dogs)
<b>Japanese yew</b>	Common shrub with toxic berries and foliage	Both
<b>Azaleas / Rhododendrons</b>	Common landscaping plants	Both
<b>Renal-toxic lilies</b>	Outdoor garden lilies	Both (extreme risk for cats)
<b>Blue-green algae</b>	Found in contaminated lakes and ponds	Both (most common with dogs)
<b>Toxic mushrooms</b>	Wild mushrooms growing in lawns and gardens	Both



## Household

TOXIN	COMMON SOURCES	CAT/DOG
<b>Rodenticides</b>	Used in pest control / baits	Both
<b>Slug and snail bait</b>	Metaldehyde—garden pest treatments	Both (most common with dogs)
<b>Mole and gopher bait</b>	Zinc phosphide—used in Rodent burrows	Both (cats are more sensitive)
<b>Sunscreen (salicylates)</b>	Beach bags and personal care products	Both (cats are more sensitive)
